

About Our Veterans

THE ENRICHMENT AND ENHANCEMENT OF LIFE FOR VETERANS BY PROVIDING OPPORTUNITIES FOR OVERALL GOAL OF FINANCIAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL WELL-BEING

Henry David Thoreau was once quoted saying, "I learned this, at least, by my experiment; that if one advances confidently in the direction of his dreams, and endeavors to live the life which he has imagined, he will meet with a success unexpected in common hours..."

It is with this thinking the Literacy Council of Carroll County (LLCC) chose a challenging goal of establishing a program focused on providing personal one-on-one literacy and occupational transition guidance and assistance for veterans.

Sam Greenholtz, Director of LLC, spoke of our new program for Veterans career assistance, as being best reflected in our vision statement, "The enrichment and enhancement of life for each and every veteran by providing opportunities for overall financial and psychological well-being."

While other entities in the State of Maryland and Carroll County have moved in this direction, the LLCC, by distinction, will provide one-on-one personal, private counselling for assessing literacy gaps needs; i.e., reading at work, math at work. The service will also include specific private, individual consultation relative to military occupational specialties learned while in military service and how those skills and knowledges can be translated for civilian occupations. Resume assistance will available, as well as honing of interview skills. Professional clothing may be provided, if needed, to make the very best impression possible.

Our anticipated date to begin offering these services is October 19, 2018. We wholeheartedly look forward to the offering of these program services to all veterans. Volunteers are welcome to help in any way!
